Award-Winning Journalist to Lecture on Board  
Travel Dynamics International's

NEW YORK, Wednesday, November 8— Prolific scholar of the world's religions **Karen Armstrong**, esteemed television journalist **Marvin Kalb**, and renowned Middle East historian **Bernard Lewis** will be among the notable lecturers accompanying Travel Dynamics International (TDI)'s luxury small-ship Mediterranean cruises in 2007, TDI co-president Vasos Papagapitos announced today.

**Ms. Armstrong**, who appeared on Bill Moyers' PBS series "Genesis" and authored numerous best-selling studies of religious history, will accompany TDI's Aegean cruise *Religion and Culture in Classical Greece: The Olympian Gods and their Sacred Places* from May 1-13, 2007, aboard the 114-passenger, all-suite *Corinthian II*. She will speak about Greek mythology on an itinerary that will explore all the major sacred sites of ancient Greece, including Delphi, Olympia, Dion as well as Delos and Samothraki.

**Mr. Kalb**, who spent a distinguished 30-year career as Chief Diplomatic Correspondent for CBS News and NBC News, will be the featured lecturer throughout TDI's July 29-August 10, 2007 departure of *The Black Sea: Crossroads of Culture from the Ancient Past to the Present*, aboard the 114-guest, all-suite *Corinthian II*. The cruise includes calls in Bulgaria, Turkey, the Crimea and Ukraine.

**Professor Lewis**, the Cleveland E. Dodge Professor Emeritus of Near Eastern Studies at Princeton University, is regarded as the most influential postwar historian of Islam and the Middle East. He will give presentations on board the November 9-21 departure of *The Lost Cities of Libya, Tunisia, and Algeria*, aboard *Corinthian II* as well.

TDI announced the inclusion of these speakers in conjunction with the release of the travel firm's 2007 Mediterranean cruise catalogue, which includes 20 original, highly unusual itineraries concentrating
